

CLUB DRESS POLICY



The Burpengary Community Club requires all patrons to be dressed in respectable attire to create a comfortable and non-offensive atmosphere for other patrons. Management reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone that does not adhere to the following standards.

DRESS STANDARDS

- ✓ Smart casual clothing is permitted at all times.
- ✓ Clothing must be in good repair (not torn or dirty).
- ✓ Hats and caps are not to be worn inside the club unless a patron has a genuine medical condition or because of religious beliefs or special events as determined by Management.
- ✓ Shirts with political or offensive wording are not permitted.
- ✓ Tops and shorts must be of appropriate length.
- ✓ Clean and tidy footwear is to be worn at all times.
- ✓ T-shirts are permitted provided they are clean and tidy.
- ✓ Fashionable (torn) jeans permitted within reason and management will make a decision on individual case.
- ✓ Rubber thongs, workwear or active wear are not permitted after 7pm.
